The memories of 20th August 1993, the 49th Birth Anniversary of late Mr. Rajiv Gandhi, will be etched in gold in the annals of Priyadarshni Academy. "Late Mr. Gandhi was a true patriot and a dynamic, energetic and handsome Prime Minister whom our nation was fortunate to have and it was only apt that his portrait should adorn the Parliament's wall".





#### **HISTORY**

On September 19, 1985, Priyadarshni Academy celebrated its first anniversary by holding an awards ceremony at Mumbai's iconic Taj Mahal Palace and Towers. It is Mr. Nanik Rupani's belief that nothing encourages talent and endeavour better than acknowledgement. The very first awards evening was attended by the entire cabinet of Maharashtra's ruling government! Not only was this a feat in itself, but Mr. Rupani had also invited the then Chief Minister of Maharashtra, Dr Shivajirao Patil Nilangekar and MPCC (I) President, Ms. Prabha Rau to attend the ceremony in spite of



the widely known political differences that had surfaced between them. It was widely said that reconnecting these two dignitaries was a unique showcase of the humanist in Mr. Rupani at work – the 'Rupani Cement'!

Now, nearly four decades on, the Priyadarshni Academy Global Awards have grown into becoming one of the rare internationally recognized humanitarian awards, instituted in India. Born in Wardha on September 22, 1923, Ramkrishna Bajaj was brought up under the personal guidance of Mahatma Gandhi and Vinoba Bhave. He participated in various satyagrahas and was imprisoned several times for a total period of three and a half years. Ramkrishna Bajaj established the Jamnalal Bajaj Foundation to fulfill the ideals for which his father dedicated his life. As a leader in the Indian industry, he was President of the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry, IMC Chambers of Commerce and Industry, National Center for Quality Management, Voluntary Forum of Labor and Management, etc. He was the Head of the Bajaj Group of companies. Earlier, he was the Chairman of Shiksha Mandal, Wardha which worked under the personal guidance of Gandhiji.

Priyadarshni Academy established a Global Award in honor of Mr. Ramkrishna Bajaj in the year 2010. The first award was given to Mr. Martin Luther King III for his outstanding contributions to human rights.

Harish Mahindra graduated from Harvard University with a Bachelor of Science degree and earned a Master's from the Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy, USA.

Harish Mahindra was a Director of Mahindra & Mahindra Ltd. and played a significant role in the company during its early days. He was the Founder Chairman of Mahindra Ugine Steel Company Ltd. and contributed greatly towards making a niche in the steel industry in India. Mr. Mahindra joined the Congress Party in 1956 and served as a Member of the Bombay Pradesh Congress Committee. He was its Treasurer from 1963 to 1967 and later became the Vice President. He served as President and Chairman of various organizations including the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry, IMC Chambers of Commerce and Industry and the Maharashtra Chamber of Commerce. He was also Founding President of the Indo-French Chamber of Commerce and was awarded the Chevalier de Legion D'Honneur by the French Government.

In honor of Mr. Harish Mahindra's contribution to corporate excellence, Priyadarshni Academy instituted a Global Award in his name in 2000 for Outstanding Contributions to the Corporate Sector.



Pralhad P. Chhabria began his career at age 12, as a cleaning boy in a small cloth shop in Karachi for a monthly wage of Rs. 10.

Working his way through stints as a domestic servant, a collection agent, a trader in electrical accessories, and a supplier of defence contracts, he flourished with the unrelenting instinct of an entrepreneur. Finolex, established in 1958 by P. P. Chhabria and his younger brother K.P. Chhabria, is today the number one manufacturer of cables in India, and second only to Reliance in the manufacture of PVC resin.

With no management mantras to follow, he applied a hands-on approach to his powerful vision, absorbing the various lessons of each step. His unassuming style attracted a devoted team to whom, as Finolex completes fifty years of existence, the company now belongs. He attributes his every success to this team, and to the forces of nature that guided him through difficult circumstances and helped him take decisions.




## PRIYADARSHNI ACADEMY LITERARY AWARDS








