Adolescence is defined by WHO as the period between 10-19 yrs and youth as 10-24 yrs. Today's generation of young people is the largest in history. Half of the world's population (almost 3 billion) is under the age of 25. By 2015 (the deadline for the Millennium Development Goals [MDGs] for which all the developing countries are striving), today's 12-year olds will be 20 and ready to fully take on the role as agents of

development. Throughout the next 10 years, today's adolescents will participate in achieving the Policy decisions regarding the education, health, employment and human rights of today's young people, which will also affect the next wave of 1.2 billion children who will be adolescents in 2015. Decisions taken today or opportunities missed will reverberate for generations to come.

Young people are crucial to the development of any country. It is especially important for our country where there are 225 million adolescents that include 12% in the 10-14 and 10% in the 15-19 yr. age groups (census 2001).

A large number of problems adolescents face are due to the risk taking behaviors inherent to this age, which can easily be prevented by providing appropriate information, education, preventive counseling, and anticipatory guidance. Adolescence is the most charming period of ones life and aptly termed the wooder years! But if not properly handled, it can lead to a variety of problems including mental health issues like anxiety, depression, suicide, and other stress-related problems. The risks taken in adolescence may have a life long negative impact, e.g., drunken driving, substance abuse, violent behavior and crimes, sexually transmitted diseases, internet abuse, etc.

Research world over has shown that those adolescents who have a strong family bond and have excellent communications with parents are less likely to go astray. With the breakdown of the family structure in the West, the teenage problems are increasing. In India, with modernization and aping of the West, we are going along the same negative path. The need of the hour is to re-establish family connections and improve communication between parents and adolescents

All parents today are sending their children to various classes to learn a number of skills to improve performance. The learning may be in academics, sports, music, dancing, painting, etc. But, does any one think of sending them to classes to improve one's mental ability to cope with

EQ (Emotional Quotient) is as important as IQ (Intelligence Quotient) to be successful in life and specially to have happiness—which is above all material success. Wost parents today want to boast about the achievements of their child in various fields—how many parents can be proud of saying that—my child is a good human being—?

Psychosocial competence is a person's ability to deal effectively with the demands and challenges of everyday life. It is a person's ability to maintain a state of mental well-being and to show this in adaptive and positive behaviours while interacting with others. WHO has devised a Life skills training program for adolescents. Life skills are "the abilities for adaptive and positive behaviours that enable individuals to deal effectively with the demands and challenges of everyday life" as they contribute to personal perceptions of self-confidence and self-esteem.

Research world over has shown that if the life skill approach is used for training adolescents in all aspects of life, the programs show excellent results as it empowers young people to take positive actions to protect themselves and to promote health and positive social relationships.

Various types of Life Skills

#### COMMUNICATION AND INTERPERSONAL SKILLS

- Interpersonal Communication Skills: verbal/nonverbal communication, active listening, expressing feelings, giving feedback (without blaming) and receiving feedback
- Negotiation/Refusal Skills: negotiation and conflict management, assertiveness skills, refusal skills
- Empathy Building: ability to listen, understand another's needs and circumstances, and express that understanding

- Cooperation and Teamwork: expressing respect for others' contributions and different styles. assessing one's own abilities and contributing to the group
- Advocacy Skills: influencing skills and persuasion, networking and motivation skills

#### DECISION-MAKING AND CRITICAL THINKING SKILLS

- Decision-making/Problem Solving Skills: information-gathering skills, evaluating future consequences of present actions for self and othersdetermining alternative solutions to problems, analysis skills regarding the influence of values and of attitudes about self and others on motivation
- Critical Thinking Skills: analyzing peer and media influences, analyzing attitudes, values, social norms, beliefs, and factors affecting them, identifying relevant information and sources of information

#### COPING AND SELF-MANAGEMENT SKILLS

- These skills give the ability to assume control, take responsibility and help bring about change in one's life: building self-esteem/ confidence, creating selfawareness skills including awareness of rights, influences, values, attitudes, strengths, and weaknesses, setting goals, self-evaluation/self-assessment/selfmonitoring skills
- Skills for Managing Feelings: managing anger, dealing with grief and anxiety, coping with loss, abuse, and trauma
- Skills for Managing Stress: time management, positive thinking, relaxation techniques

#### Global Warming ACT NOW to Save the Future

It's imperative for every one of us to focus on the subject of Global Warming and to do something about it. The phrase rings alarm bells for the future of the earth. Unless we act consciously and relentlessly from now onwards, with the kind of urgency we exercised when we faced such tragedies as Tsunami, 9/11, the massive floods of Mumbai and the bomb blasts, we will leave the world in a state that would be unlivable for our children. Global Warming will have a significant impact on every aspect of the daily lives of all human beings. The first steps towards fighting it are to make the issue a priority and enlist the help of both the civil society and the public sector. The public can be a force in helping reduce the problem.

Even though the full impact of climate change has not yet been felt, the Tsunami of 2004 and Hurricane Katrina in the U.S. in 2005 provided vivid examples of what large-scale climactic catastrophes entail.

Until a few years ago, Global Warming was an issue that was considered too technical -- best left to the scientists on earth to resolve. Not any more. The issue has garnered significant awareness in recent times and is gradually becoming one that is gripping the minds of more and more people on earth as the days tick away.

Climate is changing in many ways. Global mean temperatures have been rising steadily over the last 40 years with the six warmest years since 1860 occurring in the last decade.

Glaciers are melting at an alarming rate raising the risk of floods. Sea levels are generally rising around the world. That will flood cities and wipe coastal parts off the map. On the other hand, heat waves will give rise to droughts.

Studies suggest that the ability of the oceans to absorb carbon dioxide may be slowing. As the absorption rate declines, atmospheric build up will happen faster and climate change could speed up. If it turns out that rain and snow decline as the world warms, dwindling supplies of drinking water and fresh water for agriculture may be the next resource emergency.

Deforestation accounts for about 20% of global warming which leads to climate change. World's forests hold more carbon than in the entire hemisphere. Since trees hold carbon dioxide, conserving and increasing forest cover is a direct way of combating climate change that is caused mainly by the release of carbon dioxide into the atmosphere. Forestation helps reduce emission of carbon into the atmosphere and capture atmospheric carbon in the process. Growing trees is a potential greenhouse-gas offset, and can be done comparatively cheaply.

Many institutions and individuals are beginning to do something about Global Warming. Films are made on the subject, the print media is full of reports about its dangers,

and political leaders are placing the theme on their high priority list of areas to grapple with. Advanced technology can always help solve complex problems. Scientists. therefore, are researching to discover new ways of countering the problem through the development of new and cleaner technologies. Industrialists are undertaking R&D projects to find alternative ways of producing energy-efficient products and are putting their own environmental bestpractices plans into action in their plants and factories. Some are manufacturing solar panels, wind turbines, renewable fuel, and ethanol to blend with petrol which reduces greenhouse gas emissions. NGOs and groups of individuals are in the fray creating awareness and pressing government and institutions for action. There are moves to phase out incandescent bulbs, talk about doing away with diesel, use CNGs in vehicles, stop using electricity for an hour, and similar other measures. The government needs to develop and frame norms and put them in place and enforce them soonest.

All citizens can make a contribution, however small that may be. It will have a cumulative positive impact. They can switch to energy efficient bulbs, use fuel efficient engines in cars to reduce pollution, share the use of their vehicles to reduce the consumption of energy, reduce use of electricity, and so on. Making appropriate action a habit to help save the future of the world is a must.

#### Gist of Mr. Rupani's speech at the Convention organized by Yuvak Biradari on December 1, 2007.

It has endeavoured to establish and promote Insaani Biradari or Universal Brotherehood and is aimed at strengthening the social fabric of India in order to realise the vision of a vibrant, prosperous and enlightened India.

I understand that the organization draws its inspiration from the Preamble of the Indian Constitution and from the thoughts and visions of Mahatma Gandhi and Rabindranath Tagore. I also understand that its prime concern is national integration.

It is heartening to know that Yuvak Biradari has nurtured 15,000 youths across India through its camps and workshops. Further more, it has undertaken a tree plantation drive in June this year on the occasion of Kabir's birth anniversary. 


