CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE



NITIN GADKARI'S SPEECH TO COMMEMORATE GANDHI JAYANTI

itin Gadkari began his speech by remembering and paying homage to Gandhiji.

He said there are many issues in front of us and quoted Nehru, "India is not a

nation, it is a population, there are as many questions as there are people." Credibility of politicians has gone down. There is deterioration in all aspects of society. But, this situation can change. Gandhi had said "Ram Rajya will be established. There will be 'nyay'." This is not difficult to achieve. It can happen. He said the audience and the larger population of India are the ones who should bring that about. There is nothing lacking in our nation. We have some good natural resources everywhere, but not everything that is needed to make those resources productive. If there are metals and oil, there are not good roads to transport them. But these situations can change in six months, if there is the will of the people. If the right opportunities are provided to build airports and railway lines, there are people ready to invest and companies ready to build them.

Beginning with a five crore equity, I was able to raise 8000 crores to build infrastructure. We are a rich nation with a poor population. I learnt a lot when building the Pune express highway. I am able to continue to cogenerate power in the rural areas from biomass, ethanol, and solar energy by raising substantial monetary resources. When a project becomes capital intensive, it generates considerable employment.

Nothing is impossible. The word itself can be split into I, am, and possible. India needs people with initiative, constructive thinking, social commitment, development-oriented approach, and team spirit, and there are plenty of them. Once I was in the U.S. when discussion about the biggest capital of the 20th century took place. Some people said it is technology, some said natural resources, but what finally was agreed on as the biggest capital was the honesty, credibility, goodwill, and trust of people.

People also need to be patient when it comes to development. It will take some time, but will come.

We are a rich nation with a poor population. But, we have the strength of a democracy. However, we follow wrong economic policies and have poor governance. The biggest problem is that the competent are not coming into the political field. If good people can come, politics will become good. Qualitative change has to come in politics. Politics is the instrument of socioeconomic reform. Let there be politics for development, for increasing employment, for removal of poverty, and for increasing the GDP.

There is no salt available in some parts of Maharashtra even today. In some areas, while there is a school building, teacher is not there. If there are teachers available, a building is not there. If both are available, students are not there. If all three are present, education is absent. The doctor is not there. When people are dying, doctors do not reach there. When I was a student, I met a mother in a small village, outside a hut. When I was conversing with her, she mentioned about her daughter. When a friend beside me said I should also meet and talk to the daughter, the mother went inside and in five minutes, the daughter, who was 20 or 21, came out wearing the same sari that the mother was wearing. This is the situation in India even today.


Political inspiration should be to remove poverty, to stop suicides and save lives. These should be the mission. Politics is shameful. But, there are also good people. If only there are more and more good people, politics will change. I tell people to join the BJP; if they do not like the BJP, to join the Congress; and if they don't like either, to join SOME party. In all parties, if there are good people, qualitative change, which is badly needed, will take place. Politics has to be not power politics but national politics.

Politics will change. Transformation will happen. Good politics means bringing about good change in spite of belonging to other parties. Both the urban and rural areas will have to change. People will have to change them and be proud of the places they live in. Small, small things have to be done well, then everything will be in place. In Gujarat, the PDA system is corrupt-free. It is computerized. Even the Supreme Court has commended it. There are some great things being done in Gujarat. Such good things should be replicated elsewhere.

I commend Nanikji, because he supports good things, and also propagates them. Gandhiji devoted his entire life to the dream, 'Desh ki Bhavishya Badle'. It is important for people to think 'How much can I do'. If everybody thinks like this, change will come. Slowly, one by one, things need to change. We have to accelerate that change. Only with small, small changes will change accumulate.

Small numbers of people all over the world have brought about revolutions. There should be no negative talk, no negative approach. Everything has to be positive. National change and transformation will come. Good people in politics are needed. They don't necessarily need to seek tickets and have to be ministers. They can bring about change from the outside.

The country needs good and capable leadership and additions of capable and good people from all sections of society in politics and parties. I am reminded of Chanakya's words, 'there should be more good people than bad people'. If such awareness is created, Gandhiji's dream will be fulfilled and Ram Rajya will materialize.

From its inception in 1993 through October 2011, VFI has examined 230868 patients and operated around 37906 patients absolutely free of cost.

Priyadarshni Academy had sponsored an Eye Camp in VFI on March 12 for 128 patients mostly from the various slum areas in Mumbai. 30 of them were identified for subsequent surgery.
